CUIT format:	[C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6 C7 C8 C9 C10 C11]	Where C1 to C11 are digits.
Range:	C1...C11	Numeric.
Rules:	C1 C2	Establish the person type. These digits must be 20, 23, 24 & 27 for physical persons; 30, 33 & 34 for legal entities and 50, 51 & 55 for country CUITs.
	C3...C10	Is the CDI number for physical person or ID tax number for companies or countries.
	C11	Check digit. Was created to validate the CUIT number according the algorithm established by AFIP (Federal Tax Agency).
Sample:	012 345 678 90	Stage 1: Starting from the left, add all the characters located in the odd positions. $0 + 2 + 4 + 6 + 8 + 0 = 20$ Step 2: Multiply the sum obtained in step 1 number 3. $20 \times 3 = 60$ Step 3: Starting from the left, add all the characters that are located in the even positions. $3 + 5 + 1 + 7 + 9 = 25$ Step 4: Add the results obtained in steps 2 and 3. $60 + 25 = 85$ Step 5: Find the smallest number that added to the result obtained in step 4 of a multiple number of 10. This will be the value of the check digit of the module 10. $85 + 5 = 90$ This way you get to the number 5 is the check digit for the code module 10 01234567890 The final result: 012 345 678 905

AR3 NIP Number or CM Number. Currently, the only ID tax number for CM is the CUIT then the format is the same of "AR1A" tax category. There are 24 possible formats for NIP because it depends on each province.
