Range:	C1	Always the digit '0'.
	C2	Numeric from 1 to 9.
	C3...C10	Numeric from 0 to 9.
Rules:	[C9 C10]	Check numbers. $97 - ([C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6 C7 C8] \text{ modulo } 97)$
Sample:	0776091951	[C9 C10] $C8 C9 = 97 - (07760919 \text{ modulo } 97)$ $C8 C9 = 97 - 46$ $C8 C9 = 51$
