Sample:	30.686.957-X	<p>Check number X:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">From right to left multiply the digits by the weighting pattern digits: $7 \times 2 = 14$, $5 \times 3 = 15$, $9 \times 4 = 36$, $6 \times 5 = 30$, $8 \times 6 = 48$, $6 \times 7 = 42$, $0 \times 2 = 0$, $3 \times 3 = 9$The sum is: $14+15+36+30+48+42+0+9 = 194$Then divided the sum by 11: $194 : 11 = 17$ The rest is: $194 - (11 * 17) = 7$11- the rest of the division: $11 - 7 = 4$The result, is transform in a letter or a number, following those rules:<ul style="list-style-type: none">If the result is 11, the digit will be 0.If the result is 10, the digit will be K.In other case, the result will be the own check digit. <p>As in the exsample the result is 4, the check digit is 4.</p> <p>The number will be 30.686.957-4.</p>
