Corporation ID format:	[C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6 C7 C8 C9 C10 C11 C12 C13]	Where C1 to C13 are digits.
Range:	C1...C13	Numeric.
Rules:	C1 C2 C3 C4	The first four digits indicates competent registry office number.
	C5 C6	The fifth through sixth digits signifies the type of corporate.(e.g, Incorporated or merger of companies, foreign companies or foundation corporation etc.)
	C7 C8 C9 C10 C11 C12	The seventh through 12 th digits are sequence number.
	C13	The 13 th digit is an error checking number.

Personal ID format:	[C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6 C7 C8 C9 C10 C11 C12 C13]	Where C1 to C13 are digits.
Range:	C1...C13	Numeric.
	C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6	The first six digits signify the person's date of birth.
	C7	The seventh digit indicates the sex and the century in which the person was born.
	C8 C9 C10 C11	The eighth through eleventh digits, signifies place of birth on Korean citizens' cards. In the registration numbers of foreign residents these number indicate which agency issued the registration number.
	C12	The 12th digit, is a sequential number used to differentiate those of the same sex born on the same day in the same location.
	C13	The 13th digit, is a check digit, used to verify that the number has been transcribed correctly. It is generated from the rest of the digits using the following algorithm (digits lettered a through m in order): $m = [11 - \{(2a + 3b + 4c + 5d + 6e + 7f + 8g + 9h + 2i + 3j + 4k + 5l) \bmod 11\}] \bmod 10$
