VE1 VAT Number is called Registro de Identificación Fiscal (RIF).

RIF format:	[C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6 C7 C8 C9 C10]	Where C1 to C10 are digits.
Range:	C1	Alphabetic.
	C2...C10	Numeric.
Rules:	C1	Letter: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• V natural person born in Venezuela.• E foreign natural person.• J company.• G government.• P passport.
	C2...C9	Random numbers.
	C10	Check digit. Calculated by MOD 11.
Sample:	G200090480	Calculate the check digit (C10): <ul style="list-style-type: none">• “G” takes the value of 5 multiplied by 4 =20.• 2 multiplied by 3 = 6• 0 multiplied by 2 = 0• 0 multiplied by 7 = 0• 0 multiplied by 6 = 0• 9 multiplied by 5 = 45• 0 multiplied by 4 = 0• 4 multiplied by 3 = 12• 8 multiplied by 2 = 16 Then sum up: 20+6+0+0+0+45+0+12+16 = 99 Divided by 11: 99 / 11 = 9. The remainder is 0. 11 - 0 = 11, is greater than 9 then the check digit is 0. C10 = 0
